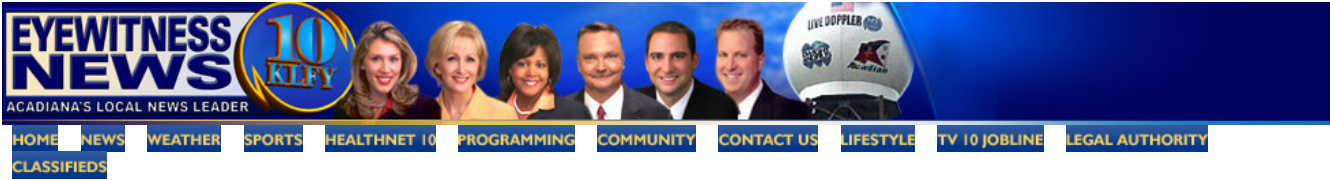

How It Works

Using World Resources Institute data, Carbonfund.org has worked with **Jets.com** to determine the carbon dioxide emission (CO2e) rates for each type of jet on the **Jets.com** network. **Jets.com** has set up an online system that calculates the carbon offset cost using the specific jet's CO2e rate, the \$5.50 unit cost for each CO2 metric ton and the estimated flight time of a given trip.

The CO2e offset cost is then presented to the **Jets.com** client when they sign the flight contract. The customer can volunteer to participate in the Carbon Neutral Flights program by checking off a box stating, "Yes, I would like my flight to be Carbon Neutral". The offset contribution, which will then be included in the cost of the trip, is 100% tax deductible. It is made in the client's name by **Jets.com** to Carbonfund.org. **Jets.com** will also forward supporting tax record documents to the customer.
